The Maryland Attorney General's Office and Office of the Secretary of State's Charitable Organization Division is pleased to share information about a resource available to small nonprofits in Maryland to help organizations comply with the law. Community Law Center, a nonprofit law firm, provides legal services to community and nonprofit organizations throughout Maryland to promote stronger nonprofits and more vibrant neighborhoods. Pro bono (volunteer) attorneys provide free legal advice, after an application fee, on issues including:

- Formation, revival, and maintenance of nonprofit organizations (including drafting and revising bylaws, filing articles of incorporation, and submitting tax exemption applications);
- Real estate leases;
- Transfer of real property;
- Zoning decision appeals;
- Contracts (drafting and negotiation);
- Employment issues;
- Copyright and trademark issues;
- Nuisance abatement; and
- Liquor license protests
