

You are hereby notified to appear before the Board of License Commissioners for Baltimore City at **3:00** o'clock AM., PM., on the **28th** day of **June 2012** 20, in Room No. **215**, City Hall, Baltimore, Maryland, to show cause why your Alcoholic Beverage License and any other permits issued by this Board to you under the provisions of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland Title "Alcoholic Beverages", as amended, should not be suspended or revoked as required of this Board by Section 10-401 of said Article, following your conviction and/or violation of said law, to wit:

Violation of Rule 4.18 "No licensee shall commit or allow the commission on his premises of any act which shall be contrary to any federal, state or local statute, law or ordinance or against the public peace, safety, health, welfare, quiet or morals" on June 1, 2012 (Re: Charter of corporation has been forfeited; licensee was previously notified prior to renewal)

PLEASE NOTE: If a certificate of good standing is submitted by June 21, 2012, the public hearing will be canceled. The licensee, however, must still pay the \$125 administrative hearing fee.

and further to show cause why your license and permits should not be suspended or revoked to promote the peace and safety of the City of Baltimore as provided by Section 10-401 of said Article. **If you fail to appear at the time and place designated above, the Board will proceed with the hearing and will take such action regarding the suspension or revocation of your license and permits as may be warranted by the evidence.**
