I represent the licensee in reference to the above-captioned matter whose license was suspended by the Board for six (6) months following a hearing on May 14, 2015. An appeal of the Board's decision is currently pending before the Circuit Court for Baltimore City. I am writing to request that the Board reconsider its decision of May 14, 2015 and reinstate the Stadium Lounge's liquor license at this time. By not being able to fully operate its business during the suspension of its license, the Stadium Lounge and its employees have suffered severe economic hardship. Continuing the suspension is likely to result in Mr. Kim losing his total investment in the business and his employees losing their jobs.
